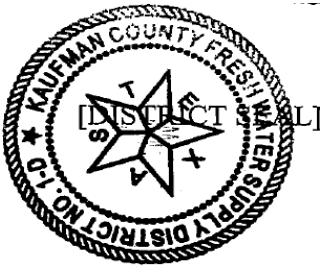

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, that the Board of Directors of Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-D will hold a public meeting on Thursday, February 6, 2020 at 12:00 noon at 2728 N. Harwood Street, Suite 500, Dallas, Texas 75201, an office located outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Call to order;
2. Public comments and communication;
3. Consider review and approval of Minutes of January 9, 2020, Board of Directors meeting;
4. Consider review and acceptance of engineer's report, and the taking of any action in connection therewith;
  - a. Status of construction projects;
  - b. Consider authorizing preparation of construction plans and specifications;
  - c. Consider approval of construction plans and specifications;
  - d. Consider approval of advertising for bids for contract(s);
  - e. Consider approval of award of construction contract(s);
  - f. Consider approval of contractor pay estimates/engineering fee statements;
  - g. Consider acceptance of certificate of completion; authorize final acceptance of facilities; and
  - h. Consider conveyance of completed District facilities.
5. Consider review and acceptance of operator's report, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
6. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;
7. Consider review and approve agreement for maintenance of detention ponds by and between the District and the Windmill Farms Homeowners' Association, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
8. Consider review and approve bookkeeping report, payment of invoices, bank resolution, budget, and related bookkeeping matters;
9. Consider review of draft budgets for fiscal year ending March 31, 2020, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate;

10. If timely, consider review and approve Resolution Granting a Franchise to Furnish and Supply Gas to the General Public in the District; and to provide for payment of same;
11. Consider any other matters that may come before the Board and take any action as may be necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
12. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
13. Adjournment.
