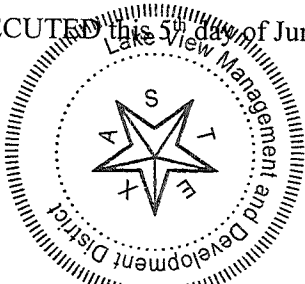
Pursuant to an Order of the Governor suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board of Directors of Lake View Management and Development District will hold a public meeting on **Thursday, June 11, 2020 at 2:00 pm solely by telephone conference** to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The meeting will be conducted in a transparent and accessible manner pursuant to the guidance provided by the Office of the Attorney General. **Any member of the public may participate in this meeting by dialing: (888) 594-6783; and entering passcode 214 745 5691#.**

1. Call to order;
2. Confirm execution of Statement of Officer Forms, Oaths of Office for newly elected Directors;
3. Consider reorganization of the Board of Directors;
4. Public communications and comments;
5. Review and approve Minutes of the April 1, 2020 Board of Directors Meeting;
6. Hear update from developer/general manager and take any action as may be necessary;
7. Hear engineer's report and take any action as may be necessary in connection with:
 - a. Status of construction projects within the District;
 - b. Authorizing preparation of construction plans/specifications;
 - c. Approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications;
 - d. Approval/ratification of advertising for bids for contracts;
 - e. Approval/ratification of District purchases and award of construction contracts;
 - f. Approval/ratification of contractor pay estimates, change orders; and
 - g. Acceptance of certificate of completion from Baker & Company Construction LLC for Long Cove Paving and Drainage Improvements;
8. Consider discussion regarding wastewater treatment plant facilities and operations, and take any action as may be necessary, including engagement of operator;
9. Consider review and approve contract with Henderson County Tax Office for collection of property taxes;
10. Review and approve bookkeeping report, payment of invoices, budget, and related bookkeeping matters, and take any action as may be necessary;

11. Consider review and approve budget for fiscal year ending July 31, 2021, and take any action as may be necessary in connection therewith;
12. Consider review and acknowledge correspondence from McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot PLLC in connection with audit for fiscal year ending July 31, 2020;
13. Consider any other matters that may come before the Board, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
14. Discuss date of next Board meeting; and
15. Adjournment.
