TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ROCKWALL COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 7 AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Pursuant to an Order of the Governor suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board of Directors of Rockwall County Municipal Utility District No. 7 (“District”) will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, July 28, 2020 at 5:30 pm solely by telephone conference** to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The meeting will be conducted in a transparent and accessible manner pursuant to the guidance provided by the Office of the Attorney General. This meeting will also be recorded and available for electronic distribution. The following items will be considered:

1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of April 28, 2020, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Confirm receipt of Statement of Officer and Oath of Office forms from newly elected Directors;
4. Hear report from engineer, including authorization of any advertisements for construction of additional District improvement projects as may be necessary; award any construction contracts, approve any pay applications or change orders relating to on-going projects and hear all engineering related updates and take any action as may be necessary;
5. If timely, confirm receipt of 2020 certified tax roll prepared by Rockwall Central Appraisal District; consider authorizing tax rate calculation services; adopt resolution;
6. If timely, review tax rate recommendation from Financial Advisor; approve proposed tax rate for 2020; adopt Notice of Water District Hearing on Tax Rate; and authorize publication of same;
7. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;
8. Review and approve bookkeeping report, and take action on bookkeeping related matters including, but not limited to; quarterly investment reports, investment recommendations, new account related matters, authorize the release of checks as noted on such report, and review existing budget related matters;
9. Consider review and approve operating and debt service budgets for fiscal year ending August 31, 2020, and take any action necessary or related thereto;

10. Discussion regarding District website, and take any action related thereto;
11. Consider review and acknowledge correspondence from McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot PLLC in connection with auditor services for fiscal year ending August 31, 2020;
12. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
13. Adjournment.
