Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 551 of the Texas Government Code, and the March 16, 2020 action of the Office of the Attorney General suspending certain requirements of Section 551, that the Board of Directors of Driftwood Conservation District will hold a regular Board meeting at **11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, August 19, 2020.**

In an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and pursuant to the Proclamation dated March 13, 2020 by Governor Greg Abbott (declaring Texas to be in a State of Disaster) and extensions thereof and associated Press Release dated March 16, 2020 from the Texas Attorney General's office (suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act), the District will be conducting this meeting by telephone conference. 1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of July 22, 2020 special Board meeting;
3. Confirm receipt from the Hays Central Appraisal District of the District's certified tax roll for 2020;
4. Review the financial advisor's Tax Rate Study and tax rate recommendation for 2020;
5. Review initial draft of proposed Operations Budget for 9/30/21 year-end;
6. Review and approve proposed Notice of Tax Rate Hearing, vote on the proposed total tax rate and authorize publication of final Notice and necessary publications/postings of such Notice;
7. Hear report from developer on status of development and review and if necessary, take action on the approval of an Amended and Restated Agreement for the Construction and Purchase of Facilities and Reimbursement for Costs or any additional actions as may be necessary;
8. Hear report from engineer, review of proposed construction projects, review and approve any needed plats, pay applications or change orders under existing contracts, partial or final acceptance of any projects, final approvals needed with respect to home building activities and connections to water supply systems, approve any necessary assignment of easements or conveyance of facilities, TxDot required agreements and related resolutions, discussions with regard to road construction, review of any bids received and recommendation letter from engineer as to award of contract, status of contract awards, authorizations for additional contract advertisements, extension requests and related matters and take necessary action with respect thereto;
9. Hear report from District's attorney and engineer as to any additional water and sewer related agreements, easements, conveyances to the City of Dripping Springs ("City"), status of negotiations with the City with respect to an Agreement Concerning Creation and Operation of the District or such other agreements and take any necessary action;
10. Hear updates with respect to proposed addition of lands and if timely, confirm City Consent to such addition, consider acceptance of a Petition or Petitions for Addition of Lands, review engineer's report in support of such addition(s), review and approve an Order Adding Lands and Redefining Boundaries and approve an Amended District Information Form and authorize recording and filing of certain documents with the Hays County Clerk and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, as well as Hays Central Appraisal District ("HCAD");
11. Review and confirm annual renewal of insurance and bonds;

12. Review Accounting Report, including but not limited to the status of accounts, checks and wires regarding payments and fund transfers, status of tax collections and approve any additional financial reporting, new accounts, discuss/confirm and execute any documents relating to pledged collateral, additional notifications to any parties due to recent change in bookkeepers and/or budget related matters and take any additional action as may be necessary;
13. Discuss and confirm next meeting dates; and
14. Adjournment.

The Board of Directors will go into Executive Session, if necessary and appropriate, pursuant to the applicable section of Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Texas Open Meetings Act, on any matter that may come before the Board. No action decision or vote on any subject or matter may be taken unless specifically listed on the agenda for this meeting.
