This meeting will also be recorded and available for electronic distribution. The following items will be considered:

1. Call to order;
2. Public communications and comments;
3. Conduct public hearing regarding District's proposed 2020 tax rate;
4. Consider review and approve Order Setting Tax Rate for 2020;
5. Review and approve Minutes of the August 13, 2020 Board of Directors Meeting;
6. Hear update from developer/general manager and take any action as may be necessary;
7. Hear engineer's report and take any action as may be necessary in connection with:
 - a. Status of construction projects within the District;
 - b. Authorizing preparation of construction plans/specifications;
 - c. Approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications;
 - d. Approval/ratification of advertising for bids for contracts;
 - e. Approval/ratification of District purchases and award of construction contracts; and
 - f. Approval/ratification of contractor pay estimates, change orders.
8. Consider operator's report, and take any action related as may be necessary;
9. Consider and approve contract for landscape maintenance services, and take any action as may be necessary;
10. Review and approve bookkeeping report, payment of invoices, budget, and related bookkeeping matters, and take any action as may be necessary;
11. Consider any other matters that may come before the Board, and the taking of any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
12. Discuss date of next Board meeting; and
13. Adjournment.
