Pursuant to an Order of the Governor suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board of Directors of Rockwall County Municipal Utility District No. 6 (“District”) will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at 6:30 pm solely by telephone conference** to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The meeting will be conducted in a transparent and accessible manner pursuant to the guidance provided by the Office of the Attorney General. 1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of September 22, 2020 Board of Directors Meeting;
3. Consider approval of an Agreed Upon Procedures Report for expenditures from proceeds of the \$6,150,000 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2020 (“Series 2020 Road Bonds”); authorize any additional action or the execution of any documents needed to close the Series 2020 Bonds; and take any action as may be necessary related thereto;
4. Consider review and approve an Amended District Information Form; and take any action as may be necessary or related thereto;
5. Hear engineer’s report, including authorization of advertisements for construction of District improvement projects, award construction contracts, approve pay estimates and/or change orders related to on-going projects, approval and acceptance of final projects and conveyances related to such projects and take any action necessary or related thereto;
6. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements, or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;
7. Review and approve bookkeeping report, and take any action on bookkeeping related matters, including amended budget; quarterly investment reports; investment recommendations; new accounts; authorize release of checks as noted on report;
8. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
9. Adjournment.
