Pursuant to an Order of the Governor suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board of Directors of Smiley Road Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 ("District") will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, May 19, 2021 at 12:00 pm solely by telephone conference** to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. 1. Call to order;
2. Public communications and comments;
3. Review and approve Minutes of March 17, 2021 Board of Directors meeting;
4. Consider review and acceptance of engineer's report including:
  - a. Status of construction projects within the District;
  - b. Authorizing preparation of construction plans/specifications for water, sewer, and drainage and paving improvements;
  - c. Consider approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications;
  - d. Consider approval/ratification of bid advertisements for construction projects;
  - e. Consider approval/ratification of award of contracts for construction projects;
  - f. Consider approval/ratification of contractor pay estimates, change orders; and
  - g. If timely, consider acceptance of certificate of completion; authorize final acceptance of improvements and/or facilities;
5. Review and acknowledge correspondence from Denton County Tax Assessor Collector in connection with Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Property Tax Assessment and Collection;
6. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements or assignments thereunder;
7. Review and approve bookkeeping report, payment of invoices, bank resolutions, tax collections report, and related bookkeeping matters, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
8. Discuss annual cybersecurity training requirements for Directors;
9. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
10. Adjournment.
