6. Consider approval of Agreed Upon Procedures Report for expenditures from proceeds of the District's Series 2021 Road Bonds;
7. Review and approve Amended District Information Form and authorize filing of same in the real property records of Rockwall County, Texas, and with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
8. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;

Review and approve bookkeeping report, and take action on bookkeeping related matters including, but not limited to; quarterly investment reports, investment recommendations, new account related matters, authorize the release of checks as noted on such report, and review existing budget related matters;
