Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code §551, that the Board of Directors of Bearpen Creek Municipal Utility District of Hunt County (“District”) will hold a special meeting on Friday, January 7, 2022, at 12:00 p.m. at 2728 N. Harwood Street, Suite 500, Dallas, Texas 75201. The Board will discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of the August 24, 2021, Organizational meeting of the Board of Directors;
3. Consider assignment of Professional Services Agreement for engineering services to Southland Consulting Engineers;
4. Consider and approve the District’s Board Resolution allowing for the acquisition by condemnation the reasonable and necessary land, easements, or other property inside or outside the district boundaries, or the boundaries of the certificated service area for a water supply corporation, necessary for water and/or sanitary sewer, in either fee simple title or a lesser property interest and take any action necessary or appropriate in connection therewith;
5. Consider and approve bookkeeper’s report, including financial and investment reports, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider any other matters that may come before the Board and take any action necessary or appropriate;
7. Adjournment.

The Board of Directors of Bearpen Creek Municipal Utility District of Hunt County conducts its Board Meetings at a designated meeting location outside the boundaries of the District. Qualified resident electors of the District may request that the Board designate a meeting location within the District and hold meetings within the boundaries of the District. The Board of Directors may enter into Executive Session, if necessary and appropriate, pursuant to the applicable section of Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Texas Open Meetings Act, on any matter that may come before the Board. No action, decision or vote on any subject or matter may be taken unless specifically listed on the agenda for this meeting.
