The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Rockwall County Municipal Utility District No. 7 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 at 5:30 p.m., at 1549 Laguna Drive, Rockwall, Texas 75087, an official meeting place outside the boundaries of the District. The roll was called of the members of the Board to-wit:

All members of the Board were present at the commencement of the meeting with the exception of Director Sinks, and Director Cook. All members present voted on all matters that came before the Board. Also present were: Mr. Jay Altom of Lennar Homes; Ms. Samantha Jones of Robert W. Baird & Co.; Mr. Daniel Rawls, P.E. of LJA Engineering, Inc.; Ms. Kerry Tovery of Dye & Tovery, LLC; and Ms. Sarah Landiak, attorney, and Ms. Genny Lutzel, paralegal, each of Winstead PC.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m.
- 2. <u>Public Communications and Comments</u>. Ms. Landiak opened the meeting for public communication and comment. After noting that there were no members of the public present, Director Christensen moved that the Board close the public communication and comment session of the meeting. Director Skinner seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 3. <u>Minutes of September 28, 2021 Board of Directors Meeting</u>. Following a discussion, Director Christensen moved that the Board approve the Minutes of the September 28, 2021 meeting, as presented. Director Skinner seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 4. <u>Engineer's Report.</u> Mr. Rawls presented to and reviewed with the Board an Engineer's Report prepared by LJA, a copy of which is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit "A"</u>. Mr. Rawls next reviewed Pay Application No. 4 for \$104,705.06 from Hammett Excavation, Inc. in connection with excavation improvements at The Reserve at Chamberlain Crossing, Phase 4, and recommended approval of same. Following a discussion, Director Christensen moved that the Board approve said pay application. Director Jones seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

- 5. Open public bids and award sale of \$1,735,000 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2021 ("Series 2021 Road Bonds"). Ms. Jones reported that three (3) qualified bids were submitted in connection with the sale of the District's 2021 Road Bonds. Next, Ms. Jones presented to and reviewed each bid with the Board as listed on the Bid Results Report dated October 26, 2021, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B", and recommended that the Board award a bid for Series 2021 Road Bonds to GMS Group, L.L.C. at an interest rate of 2.877465%. Following a discussion, Director Christensen moved that the Board award the sale of Series 2021 Road Bonds to GMS Group, L.L.C. at an interest rate of 2.877465%. (5:43 pm) Director Skinner seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 6. Approve and Authorize Execution of Series 2021 Road Bond Documents. Ms. Landiak presented to and reviewed with the Board copies of (i) an Official Bid Form dated October 26, 2021; (ii) Bond Order Authorizing Issuance of the Series 2021 Bonds; (iii) Pay Agent/Registrar Agreement; (iv) General and No-Litigation Certificate; (v) certificates and documents required by the Attorney General to secure approval of, and close the Series 2021 Road Bonds. Following a discussion, Director Christensen moved that the Board authorize the President to execute, and the Board Secretary to attest to all documents and certificates, as required. Director Jones seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 7. <u>Authorize Submission of Transcript of Proceedings to the Attorney General's office, confirmation of the next Board meeting date in advance of Series 2021 Road Bond closings for approval of an Agreed Upon Procedures Report.</u> Mr. Martin discussed the matter with the Board. Following a discussion, Director Jones moved that the Board (i) authorize submission of the Transcript of Proceedings to the Office of the Texas Attorney General; (ii) schedule the next Board meeting date for November 16, 2021; and (iii) authorize McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot PLLC to prepare a AUP Report for review at the next meeting of the Board of Directors. Director Christensen seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 8. <u>Developer Report</u>. Mr. Altom reviewed with the Board the status of development and noted 112 homes sites are currently under construction. Next, Mr. Altom stated that September 2022 is the anticipated completion date for the District.
- 9. <u>Bookkeeping Report</u>. Ms. Tovery reviewed with the Board copies of a Bookkeeper's Report dated October 26, 2021, a copy of which is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit "C"</u>. Following a discussion, Director Christensen moved that the Board (i) approve the bookkeeping report, and (ii) authorize payment of bills presented by checks drawn on the District's accounts as listed thereon. Director Jones seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.
- 10. <u>Tentative date for next meeting</u>. Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the Board elected to schedule the next Board meeting on Tuesday, November 16, 2021, at 5:47 p.m., or until further notice.
- 11. <u>Adjourn</u>. There being no further business to conduct, Director Jones moved that the meeting be adjourned at 6:13 p.m., and until further call. Director Christensen seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

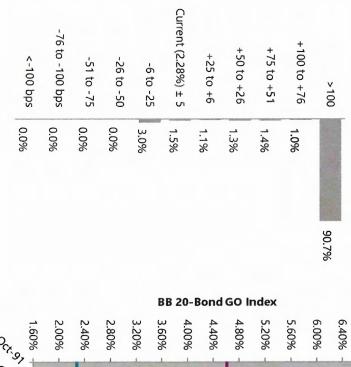

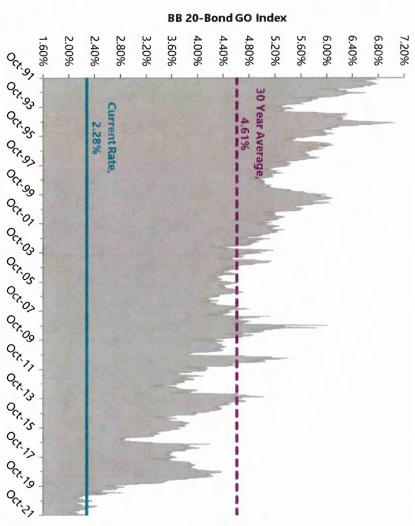






% OF TIME RATES HAVE BEEN ABOVE OR BELOW CURRENT LEVEL (IN BASIS POINTS)

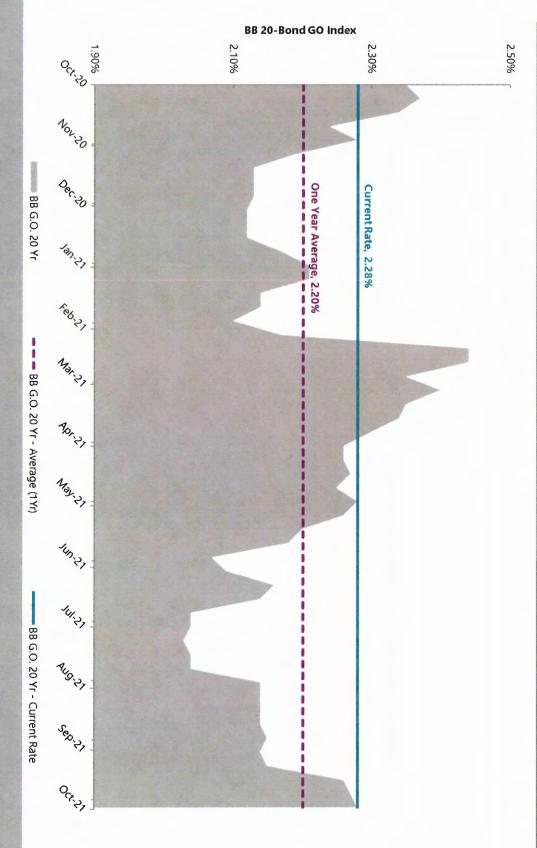
