

NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING OR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

The real property, that you are about to purchase is located in the Windsor Hills Municipal Management District No. 1 and may be subject to district taxes or assessments. The district may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The district may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. The district has not yet imposed taxes. The projected rate of the district property tax is \$1.00 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. The district may impose assessments and issue bonds and impose an assessment in payment of such bonds. The district has not yet imposed an assessment, but the projected amount of the assessment is \$-0-. The total amounts of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes approved by the voters, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters, are \$-0- for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and \$-0- for road facilities. The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are \$-0- for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and \$-0- for road facilities.

The District is located in whole or in part in the corporate boundaries of the City of Midlothian. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved.

The purpose of this District is to provide water, sewer, drainage, flood facilities, road, streets, or other type of facilities or services.
