TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DRIFTWOOD CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 551 of the Texas Government Code, that the Board of Directors of Driftwood Conservation District will hold a regular Board meeting at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at 1101 Capital of Texas Hwy., South, Building D, Suite 110, Austin, Texas 78746 for the following purposes:

1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of November 8, 2023 regular Board meeting;
3. Review and approve September 30, 2023 year-end financial statements and audit, management letter and related documents and authorize required filings and postings thereof;
4. Confirmation with respect to receipt of annual Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board Rule G-10 Disclosure Letter from the District's financial advisor, The GMS Group, L.L.C.;
5. Updates with regard to the District's pending Series 2024 Unlimited Tax Utility Bonds ("Series 2024 Utility Bonds"), and take any necessary action with regard thereto, including reviewing and authorizing finalization of the Preliminary Official Statement and Notice of Sale in connection with the District's Series 2024 Utility Bonds, setting of the sale date and required publications of sale, and take such further action as may be necessary;
6. Hear report from developer on status of development, and if necessary, take action on the approval of an Amended and Restated Agreement for the Construction and Purchase of Facilities and Reimbursement for Costs, or any additional actions in connection therewith;
7. Hear report from engineer, review of proposed construction projects, review and approve any needed plats, pay applications or change orders under existing contracts, partial or final acceptance of any projects, final approvals needed with respect to home building or other activities and connections to water supply systems, approve any necessary easements, assignments of easements or conveyance of easements or facilities, TxDOT required agreements and related resolutions, discussions with regard to road construction, review of any bids received and recommendation letter from engineer as to award of contract, status of contract awards, authorizations for additional contract advertisements, extension requests and updates, and any further actions on right of way matters or possible eminent domain proceedings and related matters and take necessary action with respect thereto;
8. Hear updates from Spitzer & Associates and/or Sheets & Crossfield with regard to closing on various easement acquisitions for the District wastewater line project and take action, as may be necessary, with regard thereto;
9. Hear report from District's attorney and engineer as to any additional water and sewer related agreements, easements, conveyances to the City of Dripping Springs ("City"), or such other agreements, as well as matters related to public financing, including but not limited to, the issuance of any bonds, bond anticipation notes or related matters, and authorize any necessary actions, as appropriate;
10. Discuss proposed addition of lands into the District, and if timely, confirm City Consent to such addition, consider acceptance of a Petition or Petitions for Addition of Lands, review engineer's report in support of such addition(s), review and approve an Order Adding Lands and Redefining Boundaries and approve an Amended District Information Form and authorize recording and filing of certain documents with the Hays County Clerk and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, as well as Hays Central Appraisal District;
11. Review and approve Cash Activity Report and related payments, authorize the opening of any new accounts and approve any necessary fund transfers, collateral agreements, and take further action with regard to any additional reporting or budget related matters;
12. If timely, hear Operations Report and take any necessary action with respect thereto;
13. Discuss and confirm next meeting date; and
14. Adjournment.

The Board of Directors will go into Executive Session, if necessary and appropriate, pursuant to the applicable section of Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Texas Open Meetings Act, on any matter that may come before the Board. No action decision or vote on any subject or matter may be taken unless specifically listed on the agenda for this meeting.

The Board of Directors of Driftwood Conservation District conducts its regular and special Board Meetings at a designated meeting location outside the boundaries of the District. Qualified resident electors of the District may request that the Board designate a meeting location within the District.
