TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF KAUFMAN COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1-A AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code §551, that the Board of Directors of Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-A (“District”) will hold a public meeting on **Tuesday, April 30, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. at 2728 N. Harwood Street, Suite 500 Dallas, Texas 75201**, an office located outside the boundaries of the District for the following purposes:

1. Call to order;
2. Public comment and communication;
3. Review and approve Minutes of April 4, 2024 Board of Directors meeting;
4. Consider review and acceptance of engineer’s report, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
 - a. Status of construction projects within the District;
 - b. Consider authorizing preparation of construction plans/specifications for water, sewer, drainage, paving and recreational facilities or repair/modification of existing facilities;
 - c. Consider approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications;
 - d. Consider approval/ratification of advertising for bids for contract(s);
 - e. Consider approval/ratification of award of construction contract(s);
 - f. Consider approval/ratification of contractor pay estimates, change orders and engineering fee statements;
 - g. Consider acceptance of certificate of completion; authorize final acceptance of facilities; and
 - h. Consider approval/ratification of repair and/or maintenance of District facilities.
5. Consider review and approve amendment to Cost-Sharing Agreement Regarding Expansions of Water Supply and Wastewater Treatment Facilities by and among the District, Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-C (“KC1C”), and Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-D (“KC1D”) dated May 1, 2021, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
6. Consider review and approve settlement agreement by and between the District and Kaufman County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1-B, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
7. Consider review and approve amendment to Joint Utility and Wholesale Allocation Agreement dated August 1, 2008, and take any action necessary or appropriate;

8. Consider discussion regarding wastewater treatment plant lease with AUC Group, LLC, cost sharing among Districts, and operation and conveyance of wastewater treatment plant and related leases to KC1C;
9. Consider discussion regarding settlement of lawsuit with AUC Group, LLC, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
10. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements, consent to Assignments, or other development related items;
11. Consider review and acceptance of operator's report, and take any action necessary or appropriate regarding utility accounts and communication; repair of District facilities; and security of District facilities;
12. Consider review and approve bookkeeping report, and take any action on bookkeeping related matters; budget; new account related matters, update list of designated banks, revisions to bookkeeping services; and authorize release of checks as noted on report;
13. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
14. Adjournment.
