Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code §551, that the Board of Directors of **Rockwall County Municipal Utility District No. 7** (“District”) will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 15, 2025 at 5:00 p.m., at the Hampton Inn at 1549 Laguna Drive, Rockwall, Texas 75087** for the following purposes:


1. Call to order;
2. Public communications and comments;
3. Review and approve Minutes of March 18, 2025 Board of Directors Meeting;
4. Hear financial advisor’s report;
5. Review and consider approval of the Preliminary Official Statement, set sale date, and authorize publication of Notice of Sale in connection with the sale of Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2025 (“Series 2025 Road Bonds”);
6. If timely, consider authorization of District consultants to prepare an Agreed-Upon Procedures Report in connection with the Series 2025 Road Bonds, and take any action as may be necessary or related thereto;
7. Consider and acknowledge representation letter from McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot PLLC;
8. Hear report from engineer, including authorization of any advertisements for construction of additional District improvement projects as may be necessary; award any construction contracts, approve any pay applications or change orders relating to on-going projects and hear all engineering related updates and take any action as may be necessary;
9. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;
10. Review and approve bookkeeping and tax collection reports, budget, and take any action on bookkeeping related matters including quarterly investment reports; investment recommendations; new account related matters; updated list of designated banks; revisions to engagement letter for bookkeeping services; adoption of financial policies; and authorize release of checks as noted on report;
11. Consider and adopt Resolution Designating Depositories and Establishing Investment Account for Deposit of District Funds;
12. Review current District Investment Policy and, if timely, approve a Resolution Acknowledging Annual Review of Investment Policy and Investment Strategies and take any action as may be necessary;

13. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and

14. Adjourn.
