Review and approve bookkeeping and tax collection reports, budget, and take any action on bookkeeping related matters including quarterly investment reports; investment recommendations; new account related matters; updated list of designated banks; revisions to engagement letter for bookkeeping services; adoption of financial policies; and authorize release of checks as noted on report;
9. If timely, consider reports from Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. and take any action as may be required;
10. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
