

ORDER SETTING TAX RATE
FOR 2025

The Board of Directors ("Board" or "Board of Directors") of WILDWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT ("District") met in regular session, open to the public, at HR Green, Inc., 4201 W. Parmer Lane, Building C, Suite 100, Austin, Texas 78727, an office accessible to the public, on September 11, 2025, whereupon the roll was called of the members of the Board of Directors, to-wit:

All members of the Board were present except Director Newby and Director Randall.

WHEREUPON, among other business conducted by the Board, Director Nagel introduced the Order set out below and moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Director Azar, and after full discussion and the question being put to the Board of Directors, said motion was carried by the following vote:

"Aye" 3 ; "No" 0 .

The Order thus adopted is as follows:

WHEREAS, the appraisal roll of Wildwood Municipal Utility District (the "District") for 2025 has been prepared and certified by the Bastrop Central Appraisal District, the appraiser for the District, and submitted to the District's tax assessor/collector;

WHEREAS, the District may levy a maintenance tax on all taxable property in the District to provide for payment of expenses as set out in Section 49.107, Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed and approved its operating budget for its fiscal year October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026 and has determined what maintenance tax rate should be set to meet such budget requirements; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WILDWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. There is hereby levied an ad valorem tax of \$1.00 on each \$100.00 of taxable property within the District in order to provide funds for maintenance and operating purposes.

Section 2. All taxes collected pursuant to this levy, after paying costs of levying, assessing, and collecting same, shall be used for planning, assisting with the maintenance and operation of the facilities that serve the District and for paying costs of proper services, engineering and legal fees, and administrative expenses or other lawfully expenses of the District.

Section 3. Ellen Owens, the Bastrop County Tax Assessor/Collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of the District employing the above tax rate.

Section 4. The taxes levied hereby are due presently, and shall be delinquent if not paid by January 31, 2026.

Section 5. This Order Setting Tax Rate shall be effective from and after its adoption.


Section 6. The President or Vice President is authorized to execute, and the Secretary or any Assistant Secretary to attest, this order on behalf of the Board of Directors.
