Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code §551, that the Board of Directors of **Rockwall County Municipal Utility District No. 6** (“District”) will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 6:30 pm at the Hampton Inn at 1549 Laguna Drive, Rockwall, Texas 75087** for the following purpose:

1. Call to order;
2. Confirm receipt of Statement of Officer and Oath of Office forms from newly-elected Directors; and discuss government training pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code;
3. Consider reorganization of the Board of Directors;
4. Public communications and comments;
5. Consider discussion regarding meeting locations and regular board meeting dates;
6. Review and approve Minutes of March 17, 2026 Board of Directors Meeting;
7. Consider discussion regarding District website management, review proposals and take any other action as may be required;
8. Consider termination of Robert W. Baird & Co., Inc. (“Baird”), as financial advisor to the District, acknowledge waiver of 30-day notice period by Baird; consider engagement of Cedar Creek Municipal Advisors, LLC; and take any other action as may be required or related thereto;
9. Hear financial advisor’s report;
10. Hear engineer’s report, and take any action necessary or related thereto;
11. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements, or assignments thereunder;
12. Review and approve bookkeeping and tax collection reports and take any action on bookkeeping related matters including quarterly investment reports; investment recommendations; new account related matters; updated list of designated banks; revisions to engagement letter for bookkeeping services; adoption of financial policies; and authorize release of checks as noted on report;
13. Consider and adopt Resolution Designating Depositories and Establishing Investment Account for Depositor of District Funds;

14. Review current District Investment Policy and, if timely, approve a Resolution Acknowledging Annual Review of Investment Policy and Investment Strategies and take any action as may be necessary;
15. If timely, consider reports from Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc. and take any action as may be required;
16. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
17. Adjournment.
