Notice is hereby given pursuant to Texas Government Code §551, that the Board of Directors of East Lake Houston Management District (“District”) will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 12:00 noon at Arete Real Estate & Development Company, 340 N. Sam Houston Parkway, Suite 140, Houston, Texas 77060. The Board will discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public communications and comments;
2. Review and approve Minutes of the July 28, 2026, Board of Directors Meeting;
3. Conduct public hearing regarding proposed assessments on land within the Crosby Pines Improvement Area of the District, a Service and Assessment Plan, and Crosby Pines Assessment Roll;
4. Consider, review and adopt Assessment Order approving Service and Assessment Plan and levying Assessments on land within the Crosby Pines Improvement Area of the District;
5. 12. Consider, review and adopt Assessment Order approving Service and Assessment Plan and levying Assessments on land within the Lone Wolf Improvement Area #1 of the District;
13. Consider review and adopt an Order Authorizing the Issuance of East Lake Houston Management District Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2026C (Lone Wolf Improvement Area #1 Project) (the “Lone Wolf IA#1 Project Bonds”) in accordance with the terms of that certain Indenture of Trust; approving and authorizing the execution of the Indenture of Trust, authorizing a final Limited Offering Memorandum pertaining to the issuance of Lone Wolf IA#1 Project Bonds; approving a Bond Purchase Agreement; providing an effective date and containing other matters related to the Lone Wolf IA#1 Project Bonds;
14. Consider review and approve any and all documents or other agreements needed to close the sale of the Lone Wolf IA#1 Project Bonds, including the Continuing Disclosure Agreement of the Issuer and agreement for collection of assessments, if timely or necessary, and authorize the filing of the transcript for the Lone Wolf IA#1 Project Bonds with the Attorney General;
15. Conduct public hearing regarding proposed assessments on land within the Lone Stag Improvement Area #1 of the District, a Service and Assessment Plan, and Lone Stag IA#1 Assessment Roll;
16. Consider, review and adopt Assessment Order approving Service and Assessment Plan and levying Assessments on land within the Lone Stag Improvement Area #1 of the District;
17. Consider review and adopt an Order Authorizing the Issuance of East Lake Houston Management District Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2026D (Lone Stag Improvement Area #1 Project) (the “Lone Stag IA#1 Project Bonds”) in accordance with the terms of that certain Indenture of Trust; approving and authorizing the execution of the Indenture of Trust, authorizing a final Limited Offering Memorandum pertaining to the issuance of Lone Stag IA#1 Project Bonds; approving a Bond Purchase Agreement; providing an effective date and containing other matters related to the Lone Stag IA#1 Project Bonds;
18. Consider review and approve any and all documents or other agreements needed to close the sale of the Lone Stag IA#1 Project Bonds, including the Continuing Disclosure Agreement of the Issuer and agreement for collection of assessments, if timely or necessary, and authorize the filing of the transcript for the Lone Stag IA#1 Project Bonds with the Attorney General;
19. Hear report from operator and take any action necessary or appropriate regarding utility accounts and communication, repair of District facilities, security of District facilities, or other operations related items;

20. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements, addition of lands, or assignments thereunder, or other development related items;
21. Consider review and acceptance of engineer's report, and take any action necessary or appropriate;
 - a. Status of construction projects within the District;
 - b. Consider authorizing preparation of construction plans/specifications for water, sewer, paving and recreational facilities or repair/modification of existing facilities;
 - c. Consider approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications;
 - d. Consider approval/ratification of advertising for bids for contract(s);
 - e. Consider approval/ratification of award of construction contract(s);
 - f. Consider approval/ratification of contractor pay estimates, change orders and engineering fee statements;
 - g. Consider approval/ratification of purchase or conveyance of easements and rights-of-way, and any and all documents related to same; and
 - h. Consider acceptance of certificate of completion and authorize final acceptance of facilities.
22. Review and approve bookkeeping report, adopt any necessary resolutions and approve signature cards relating to any new accounts, investment report, update listing of depositories, review tax collections, and take further action on such matters as may be necessary with regard to bookkeeping matters;
23. If timely, enter into executive session for consultation with District's attorney pursuant to Texas Government Code, §551.071;
24. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
25. Adjournment.

The Board of Directors may enter into Executive Session, if necessary and appropriate, pursuant to the applicable section of Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Texas Open Meetings Act, on any matter that may come before the Board. No action, decision or vote on any subject or matter may be taken unless specifically listed on the agenda for this meeting.
