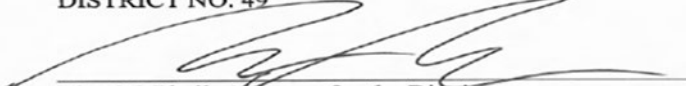
1. Public communication and comments;
2. Review and approve the Minutes for the July 9, 2026 Board meeting;
3. If timely, review and discuss proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year of October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027 and take any necessary action with respect thereto;
4. Confirm receipt from the Williamson Central Appraisal District of the District's certified tax roll for 2026;
5. Review the financial advisor's Tax Rate Study and tax rate recommendation for 2026;
6. Review TNT worksheet and authorize publication of same;
7. Review and approve proposed Notice of Tax Rate Hearing, vote on the proposed total tax rate and authorize publication of final Notice and necessary publications/postings of such Notice;
8. Discuss appraisal of homes within the District;
9. Update from the developer as it relates to the status of development within the District;
10. If timely, review and approve an amendment to the Consent and Development Agreement with the City of Jarrell, Texas, LGI Homes-Texas, LLC and the District and take any necessary action with respect thereto;
11. Hear engineer's report, review any needed plat approvals, pay applications or change orders under existing contracts, and if timely, take any necessary actions with respect to any plan or plat approvals, authorize any additional formal bidding for construction contracts for additional phases of development, subject to receipt of necessary approvals, review of bids received and recommendation letters from engineer as to award of contracts, award of contracts and authorize notice to proceed, authorize partial or final acceptance of any projects and action with regard to substantial completion or final completion of any on-going contracts, general discussions with regard to construction and bond services and take any necessary action with respect thereto;
12. Review and approve Cash Activity Report and related payments, approve necessary fund transfers, and take further action with regard to any additional reporting or budget related matters;
13. Discuss and confirm the next proposed meeting date; and
14. Adjournment.
